Call for Proposals

“Arsen-Djurović-Prize for Historical Research on Textbooks”

The Prize

The “Arsen-Djurović-Prize for Historical Research on Textbooks” is awarded every two years to **one or more member(s) of the “International Society for Research on Textbooks and Educational Media e.V.”** (IGSBI). In memory of the renowned Serbian textbook researcher Prof. Dr. Arsen Djurovic, former Vice President of the Society, the prize, which is donated by his widow Dr. Milica Djurović, honors studies, which deal with the history of textbooks – for example with their production, distribution, use, and impact.

The prize money is **1,000 Euro**. The prize may be split if indicated.

Application

Applicants (self-nominations or proposals of other authors) are invited to submit (at least) three articles or one monograph from the area of historical research on textbooks; the last publication may not be older than two years. The publications shall make an important contribution to historical research on textbooks with regard to contents and/or methods.

The texts should preferably be in German or in English; otherwise detailed abstracts of the texts in German or in English have to be added.

Jury

The jury consists of the members of the Managing Board of the Society. Further reviewers will be consulted if necessary.

Submission

Self-nominations or proposals of other authors (with precise bibliographical data of the relevant texts) can be submitted by members of the Society **until June 15, 2019**, to the President of the Society, Prof. Dr. Eva Matthes, preferably via e-mail.
